What is Parkinson's Disease? Parkinson's disease is a Motor System Disorder. The disease is both chronic, meaning it persists over a long period of time, and progressive, meaning its symptoms grow worse over time. Symptoms include slowness of movement, loss of balance and coordination, tremor, rigidity or stiffness, and uncontrolled movements. As these symptoms become more pronounced, patients may have difficulty walking, talking, or completing daily tasks.

Over 1.5 million people in the U.S. have Parkinson's, of which over 26,000 are in Wisconsin. Most people with Parkinson's are over 60, but an estimated 20 percent are young adults under 50.

Every day, researchers are learning new facts about how the brain works. New drugs are being tested and new surgeries performed. Parkinson's research is so promising that scientists are optimistic about finding a cure in the near future.
